REPORT OF THE FINANCE AND BUDGET COMMITTEE

It has been our privilege to serve as your Budget and Finance Committee for the preceding Templar year. We have reviewed the records of the Grand Treasurer, and taken a look at the condition of our investment portfolio. We find the Grand Treasurer's record well-kept and properly cast. We will defer to the Grand Treasurer for the details thereof.

Needless to say, the investments of the Grand Commandery were not immune to the financial crisis that devastated the portfolios of many investors. Our portfolio has recovered well. For the future, we believe that a well-diversified portfolio will continue to serve the long term objectives of this Grand Commandery. That said, last year's budget called for transfers of funds from both the Triennial and Conclave reserves in order to balance the budget. We are happy to report that due to the care taken by the Grand Officers in controlling expenses, and the outstanding work of the York Rite Council in bringing the Annual Conclave in under budget, the budget deficit was funded in its entirety by a surplus from the preceding year. The funds that were to have been transferred were able to remain invested, which resulted in additional gains. Attached are the Budgeted Income and Expenses compared to the actual expenses to date for the current year along with a proposed Budget for Fiscal Year 2011. Based on the frugal management of our Conclave expenses, and the size of our Conclave Reserves, we recommend a reduction in the Grand Commandery Assessment, to \$2.00 per capita for the Conclave from the current \$3.00 per capita

Your Committee will meet with Robert L. Sutherland Jr. Sect/Tres REPGC, to discuss the Educational Scholarship Program.

The following committee members: William F. Curtis, REPGC Chairman (2011), Robert D. Steel (2012), Mark H. Kilmister (2013) Glen R. Gordon (2014) Harold M. Chase VEDGC (2010) will meet and discuss the business of the Committee. It should be noted that the term of Sir Knight Chase (2010) expired on December 31st 2010 and that a new trustee (pro tem) was selected by the Committee to serve until an election may be held at the Annual Business Conclave, he being RE Sir Knight Ronald E. Metcalf and his term would expire 2015.

The Education Recorder worked with the Grand Encampment to get all the past paper work from 2005 to 2010 budget filed. Due to a miss statement of an employee of the Grand Encampment finical statements for the years of 2005, 2006, and 2007 were not filled. Also budgets for years 2006, 2007 and 2008 were not filed. After this was cleared up all the finical statements were completed and filed and the budget for 2008 completed and filed within eight days. Budgets for 2009 to 2011 were filled and all other paper work is now current with the Grand Encampment. The Grand Encampment has approved the budget for 2011-12 signed it and returned it. The Grand Encampment has developed a new reporting system that makes the filing of all of our annual federal reports and Grand Encampment reports very easy, they are now PDF fill in reports and simple to save and send.

Last year we received a very large donation from a SK via Trinity Commandery in the sum of some \$30,000.00. This increases the value of our base holding to over 100,000 dollars, and increasing the income of our account.

This past year we had a lower request in the number of scholarship and we with the dips and dives of the market we will able to make three \$1000.00 this year. We had four outstanding students apply this past

All applicants must have a Masonic affiliation to be eligible. All application forms must be completed and returned to the Education Recorder no later than April 30th, 2011.

Due to the fact that Trustee terms expire on December 31st we recommend the election of RESK Ronald E. Metcalf for the balance of his appointed term till 2015 and that RESK Curtis be reelected for an other term of five year to expire in 2016. REPORT OF THE MEMBERSHIP COMMITTEE

TO: THE RIGHT EMINENT GRAND COMMANDER, OFFICERS AND MEMBERS OF THE GRAND
COMMANDERY OF KNIGHTS TEMPLAR, STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

It has been our privilege to serve as your Membership Committee for the preceding Templar year.

This year, no festival was planned in Manchester as in the two previous years, so it was interesting to see if the interest in the Rite would continue and spread throughout the State. There has been activity throughout the state, beginning in August in Claremont, where 6 men began their York Rite journey. At least 15 have joined our ranks since our last Annual Session, and there has been activity in every Commandery or in the associated Chapters and Councils. Currently, there are 6 men waiting for Council Degrees, along with several others at various stages in Chapter and Council. Portsmouth will begin another class in April.

During the year, the Chair had an opportunity to work with the YRIS in order to update and verify the records of his own Trinity Commandery. An interesting discovery came to light: Of the 120+ members of Trinity Commandery, 40 have joined since March, 2007. This certainly explains why there are no new Past Commanders since that time. We recommend that other Commanderies review their records as well, as we think it will be enlightening.

The balance of this report will reiterate points we have made in prior reports.

We believe it is time for the membership function of the York Rite Bodies to become a unified effort, and recommend that the several presiding Grand Officers work to create a York Rite Membership Task Force with responsibility for coordinating all membership and promotional activities

We believe that a coordinated effort aimed at informing all York Rite Bodies within the State exactly when and where the several York Rite Degrees and Orders are being exemplified will enable us to sustain and grow our order.

Our Brethren in the Scottish Rite have developed a well-financed and well-coordinated effort to recruit new members. The Supreme Council, NMJ has even made an appeal to the general membership for funds to assist in this effort. Sir Knights, we must develop an answer, so that our brethren will know that there is not just one path available to the Master Mason seeking further light.

We should not make this a completion, but the truth is that nonmember Scottish Rite brethren are the best source of prospective members. We must make sure that new Master Masons are informed about the opportunities for further light within our Rite, and we must do it early. Research done by our Scottish Rite brethren suggests that the likelihood of a Brother seeking further light decreases rapidly within a year of being raised. Remember Sir Knights, we in the York Rite do have a Unique Selling Proposition, which others do not: We have the "Rest of the Story!" In addition, we are not

continually involved in rewriting our traditions to address some perceived demographic trend. New Master Masons are interested in history and tradition, and we can offer both. Some of the specific activities on which we have worked this year include:

- *A presentation of the York Rite opportunity in at least one Lodge in the 3rd District. If other presentations were made, they have not been reported to this committee.*
- *A brief presentation on the York Rite opportunity at various blue lodge visitations within the 2nd district, along with the Commander in Chief of New Hampshire Consistory.*

Recommendations:

- *That the membership function of this Grand Commandery be combined with those of the other two Grand York Rite Bodies under the direct supervision of the a York Rite Membership Task Force.*
- *That the membership effort be coordinated with public relations with the aim that every York Rite body within the State will know when and where degrees and orders are being exemplified.*
- *That a cohesive approach utilizing an “ambassador” approach be developed, implemented and communicated to the several Lodges within the state, the objective being that each Lodge will have a “go to” person for information about the York Rite*
- *That this Grand Commandery, of its own accord, or in conjunction with the other Grand York Rite Bodies, attempt to present or make available something of value to each newly raised Master Mason within the State. Said item would provide information regarding the York Rite opportunity or perhaps on the availability of paths to further light in general. Two examples are The York Rite of Freemasonry, available through Grand Encampment, and Further Light, available from the Masonic Services Association. We favor the second, as it provides information on nearly every Appendant and concordant Masonic organization in existence. We believe the unbiased approach will create a favorable impression.*
- *That each of us be visible in the Blue Lodges around the State, seeking opportunities to dispense information regarding the Order and membership therein.*

Right Eminent Grand Generalissimo (2009-2010)

Sir Knight Sid Cornelius Dorris, III was born November 3, 1947 in Nashville, Tennessee. He attended public schools in Goodlettsville, Tennessee and graduated from the School of Modern Photography in 1968. He served in the United States Army Reserves as a Public Information Office Photographer. Sid was employed for forty years at the United Methodist Publishing House in Nashville, Tennessee as Photography Manager and retired August 2005.

Sir Knight Sid married Sherry L. Damron in 1970. Lady Sherry predeceased Sid on August 9, 2010. They are survived by one child Chad Brandon Dorris, his wife, Tia, and two grandchildren, Barrett Grey and Kate Elizabeth Dorris. Sid and Sherry were active members of Hermitage United Methodist Church.

Brother Dorris began his Masonic career in 1974, when he was raised to the sublime degree of Master Mason at McWhirtersville Lodge No. 375 in Donelson, Tennessee, where he served as Worshipful Master in 1985. Sir Knight Dorris was elected Most Worshipful Grand Master of Free & Accepted Masons of Tennessee on March 23, 2006.

Sir Knight Dorris was an active member of many Masonic Affiliated Organizations:

Exalted in Donelson Chapter No. 234 in 1975, he served as the High Priest in 1985 and 2001 and received the Order of the High Priesthood in 1986. He received the Bronze Medal for Distinguished Service from the General Grand Chapter of Royal Arch Masons International. Companion Dorris was greeted in Nashville Council No. 1 in 1975 and served as Illustrious Master in 1986. He received the Order of the Silver Trowel in 1987 and served the Grand Council of Cryptic Masons as Grand Conductor of the Council in 1986.

Ancient & Accepted Scottish Rite, Southern Jurisdiction, in the Valley of Nashville, where he was Invested a Knight Commander of the Court of Honor in 1991 and Coroneted a 33° Inspector General Honorary in 2003; Masonic Societas Rosicruciana In Civitatibus Foederatis in Tennessee College where he was Past Celebrant and Past Secretary, IX Grade and First Ancient of the High Council of the Order; Holy Royal Arch Knight Templar Priest in Holy Tabernacle No. XLVIII and Grand Inner Guard of the Grand College of America.

Other memberships included:

Tennessee Priory No. 15, Knights of York Cross of Honour, where he served as Prior in 2006; Old Hickory Conclave, Red Cross of Constantine, where he served as Sovereign in 1997; Middle Tennessee York Rite College No. 143, where he served as Governor in 1992; Arch E. McClanahan Council 358, Allied Masonic Degrees, where he served as Sovereign Master in 2004; Tralee Council No. 41, Knight Masons; Royal Order of Scotland; Buchanan Chapter No. 286, Order of the Eastern Star; Al Menah Shrine Temple; Tennessee Lodge Of Research; National Sojourners and Hero's of 76.

He was a recipient of the DeMolay Legion of Honor and honored with the Order of the Purple Cross from the York Rite Sovereign College of North America.

Sir Knight Dorris was knighted in Nashville Commandery No. 1 in 1975 and served as Commander in 1986. He served the Grand Commandery of Tennessee as Right Eminent Grand Commander in 1994.

In the Grand Encampment of Knights Templar, he served as Aide-de-Camp (1997-2000) for Grand Master James M. Ward and was the Co-Chairman of the 61st Triennial Conclave held in Nashville, Tennessee in 2000. Sid received the Knight Commander of the Temple in 2000 and served on the Public Relations Committee from 2000 to 2003. He served as the Southeastern Department Commander (2003-2006) for Grand Master Kenneth B. Fischer. Sir Knight Dorris was elected Right Eminent Grand Captain General and received the Knight Grand Cross of the Temple in our Order in August 2006. He was elected Right Eminent Grand Generalissimo in 2009 in Roanoke, Virginia and was serving in that office at the time of his death.

WILLIAM HENRY THORNLEY, JR.

Most Eminent Grand Master, 1991-1994

Sir Knight William Henry Thornley, Jr., was born December 21, 1924, in Meyersdale, Pennsylvania. He attended Carnegie Institute of Technology before the War, and came to Colorado in 1946 to attend the Colorado School of Mines. He had three children: Elizabeth (Mrs. William H. Koon, II), William III and Robert. His wife, Shirley, died in September 1991.

A Registered Professional Engineer, Sir Knight Thornley was a Consulting Materials Engineer. He is a Fellow of the American Society of Civil Engineers, a member of the National Society of Professional Engineers, American Institute of Mining Engineers, Society of American Military Engineers, U.S. Committee for Large Dams, International Committee for Soil Mechanics and Foundation Engineering and the American Society for Testing Materials.

A veteran of World War II, he served with the 90th Infantry Division in Europe where he was wounded and decorated for gallantry in action four times. He holds four campaign stars and the Normandy Invasion Arrowhead. He was a member of Christ Church, Episcopal.

He received the degree of Master Mason on June 25, 1946, in King Solomon's Lodge No. 346, F. & A.M. Connellsville, Pennsylvania, and the Capitular Degrees in Colorado Chapter No. 29, R.A.M., serving as High Priest in 1959 and Treasurer for many years. In the Grand Chapter of Royal Arch Masons of Colorado he served as Most Excellent Grand High Priest in 1966; his Cryptic record shows membership in Denver Council No. 1, C.M., where he served as Thrice Illustrious Master in 1977. He served the Grand Council of Cryptic Masons of Colorado as Most Illustrious Grand Master in 1986. He was a member of both the Order of High Priesthood and the Order of the Silver Trowel.

Sir Knight William was Knighted September 13, 1950, in Denver Commandery No. 25, KT. (now Denver-Colorado Commandery No. 1, K.T.), and served as 1st Lieutenant of the Drill Team from 1952-60, Eminent Commander in 1960, and Right Eminent Grand Commander of the Grand Commandery of Colorado in 1976. He was the Charter Commander of St. Bernard Commandery No. 41, K.T., when it was formed in 1983. He was Past President of the Colorado Past Commanders Association.

In the Ancient and Accepted Scottish Rite, Sir Knight Thornley was a member of Rocky Mountain Consistory, Valley of Denver, Orient of Colorado, where he was Venerable Master of the Centennial Lodge of Perfection and a 33^o, Inspector General Honorary, Southern Jurisdiction.

Appendant Masonic Bodies include: El Jebel Temple, AAONMS; Mount of the Holy Cross Conclave, Red Cross of Constantine; Crown of Thorns Tabernacle No. XXVIII, HRAKTP; Served as Most Eminent Grand Preceptor, Grand College of America, HRAKTP in 1999. Royal Order of Scotland; Centennial York Rite College No. 87; Kincora Council No. 8, Knight Masons; Pikes Peak Council No. 156, A.M.D.; Colorado College, S.R.I.C.F.; Served as Grand Chancellor of the Grand College of Rites in 1998; Served as Sovereign Grand Master of the Grand Council of Allied Masonic Degrees of USA in 1996-97; He holds the Honorary Legion of Honor and was an Emeritus Member of the International Supreme Council, Order of DeMolay.

Appointed Right Eminent Department Commander of the Northwestern Department by Grand Master Willard M. Avery, October 17, 1978, and reappointed by Grand Master Kenneth C. Johnson, August 15, 1979. Elected Right Eminent Grand Captain General, August 18, 1982, at Hot Springs National Park, Arkansas. Elected Right Eminent Grand Generalissimo, August 13, 1985, at Cincinnati, Ohio. Elected Right Eminent Deputy Grand Master, August 9, 1988, at Lexington, Kentucky. Elected Most Eminent Grand Master, August 20, 1991, at Washington, D.C.

Sir Knight Thornley died on December 21, 2010, in Pennsylvania.

RULES FOR MASONIC DATES IN 2004

ANCIENT CRAFT MASONRY

Commence their era with the creation of the world, calling it ANNOS LUCIUS (A.L.), "In the year of Light". Add 4000 years to the common era. Thus 2004 plus 4000 would be 6004 A.L.

ROYAL ARCH MASONS

Dates from the year the construction of the Second Temple was commenced by Zerubbabel, ANNO INVENTIONIS (A.I.), "In the year of the Discovery". Add 530 years to the common era. Thus 2004 plus 530 would be 2543 A.I.

ROYAL AND SELECT MASTERS

Dates from the year in which the Temple of Solomon was completed, ANNO DEPOSITIONIS (A. DEP.), "In the year of Deposit". Add 1000 years to the common era. Thus 2004 plus 1000 would be 3004 A.Dep.

ORDER OF HIGH PREISTHOOD

Dates from the year of the blessing of Abraham by the High Priest Melchisedek, ANNO BENEFACTO (A.B.), and "The year of the Blessing." Add 1913 years to the common era. Thus 2004 plus 1913 would be 3917 A.B.

KNIGHTS TEMPLAR

Commence their era with the organization of the Order, ANNOS ORDINIS, (A.O.), "In the year of the Order." Subtract 1118 from the common era. Thus 2004 minus 1118 would be 886 A.O.
